NATIVE LAND COURTS.

The business transacted by the Native Land Court and the Native Appellete Court is set out in Table A. The fees collected amounted to $\pounds 3,748$, as against $\pounds 3,877$ for the preceding period.

MAORI LAND BOARDS.

The Boards received in fees £1,231, as against £1,641 last year, a decrease of £410, while the commissions collected fell from £4,149 last year to £2,618, a decrease of £1,531, making a total decrease of £1,941.
