REMARKS.

- (b) Payment for services rendered during the six months ended 11th May, 1938.
- (c) It is proposed to equip four Traffic Inspectors with motor-cycles for use on roads carrying heavy traffic.
- (d) Provision to meet increased running-costs.
- (e) Tires removed from patrol cars are being sold to the public under authority from the Stores Control Board.
- (f) Six sirens have been sold to the Police Department.
- (g) This amount represents contributions to be received from small boroughs for the control of traffic by the Department's Traffic Inspectors.
