Extracts from the Journals of the House of Representatives.

FRIDAY, THE 14TH DAY OF JULY, 1939.

Ordered, "That the New Zealand Federation of Funeral Directors Bill be referred to the Public Health Committee."—(MR. O'BRIEN.)

FRIDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF JULY, 1939.

Ordered, "That a Select Committee be appointed, consisting, by leave, of eleven members, to consider all matters relating to public health, infectious diseases, contagious diseases, hospitals, and to local authorities having charge of these matters, and to other matters affecting public health which may be referred to it: the Committee to consist of Mr. Allen, Mr. Anderton, Mr. Boswell, Mr. Coleman, Mr. Grigg, Mr. Kyle, Dr. McMillan, Mr. Richards, Mr. Roy, Mrs. Stewart, and the Mover." (HON. MR. FRASER.)

THURSDAY, THE 3RD DAY OF AUGUST, 1939.

Ordered, "That all petitions not finally dealt with during the session of 1938 be again referred to the same Committees as they were referred to during the said session."—(HON. MR. FRASER.)

THURSDAY, THE 14TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1939.

Ordered, "That the Nurses and Midwives Registration Amendment Bill be referred to the Public Health Committee."—(HON. MR. FRASER.)

FRIDAY, THE 22ND DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1939.

Ordered, "That the Pharmacy Bill (No. 2) be referred to the Public Health Committee."—(HON. MR. SULLIVAN.)

FRIDAY, THE 22ND DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1939.

Ordered, "That the Public Health Committee have leave to sit during the present sitting of the House."—(HON. MR. SULLIVAN, for Dr. McMILLAN.)
