**Stolen.**

STOLEN, at Temuka, between 5 p.m. 12th, and 8 a.m. 13th November, 1874, one gallon of turpentine, in a tin varnish can 13in. high by 4in square, labelled "best elastic oak varnish; James Price, Edmonton, London; for house painters and builders." Not identifiable.

STOLEN, from the person of George Osbourne, at the Oxford Hotel, Christchurch, at 10 p.m. on the 11th November, 1874, a gold hunting lever watch, No. 23547. Martin O'Keefe, *vide* discharged prisoners, *Police Gazette*, 1874, page 132, is suspected.

STOLEN, from the person of Robert Tindall, at the racecourse, between the hours of 5 and 8 p.m. on the 13th November, 1874, a silver lever watch; R. Tindall, engraved on inside of case.

STOLEN, from Springston, on the 29th September, 1874, a black cattle bitch, with long shaggy hair, answers to the name of "Lass," the property of Joel Reed, blacksmith. William Baker, and a man name unknown, took the bitch. Baker ran away from his ship nine months ago, and is described as English, about 35 years, 5ft. 4in., stout build, dark complexion, black beard, whiskers, and moustache, whiskers worn long; dressed in suit of dark tweed, carried a grey blanket swag.
