67. (1.) (2.) (3.) Ia tangata e mahi ana i te hara pahoneihana e awhina ana ranei, e tautoko ana, e tohutohu ana, e whakahaere ana ranei kia mahia taua tu hara e tetahi atu tangata, ka ahei kia whiu ki te herehere mo nga tau e rua, me te mahi taumaha kaore ranei.

Ka whakaaetia nga utu o te whakawakanga.

(4.) Ko nga moni (*costs*) me nga moni i pau i te taha ki te kai-tono whakawa me nga kai-korero i roto i taua keehi, hui atu hoki ki nga moni kapeneheihana mo to ratou raruraru me te paunga o to ratou taima, me whakaao e te Kooti.

(5.)
