Kia whakaactia he tapahi-rakau i runga i he wahi o taua poraka, e 223 eka 1 ruuri, kua oti nei he whakaatu o tona ahua i he mapi kei kōuci e mau ana he whero nga rohe o waho ki a Munro Wilson me Cecil Davis, of Rotorua, tangata mocho whenua, mo nga tau 15 apiti atu ki tetahi 5 tau mehemea kaore e pau te tapahi o nga rakau i te 15 tau tuatahi, ko he roireti ls. ia rau putu; ko nga rakau katoa e hiahijatiaana mo he whakatu i nga whare o te mira; i nga whare o nga kai mahi, i nga piriti me nga raena o nga taramu kaua he utu ai etahi atu tikanga take ranci e whaknaetia e te huihuinga. (That timber-cutting rights over part of the above block, containing 223 acres 1 rood, as more particularly described on plan attached hereto, edged red, be granted to Munro Wilson and Cecil Davis, both of Rotorua, settlers, for a term of 15 years, with a right of renewal for a further term of 5 years if the timber thereon is not exhausted within the first 15 years, at a royalty of ls. per hundred superficial feet log measurement; all timber required for the erection of mill-buildings, men's cottages, bridges, and tramline to be free of charge; and upon such other terms and conditions as may be agreed upon at the said meeting.)

(That a lease be granted to Charles Alfred Smith, of Gisborne, Accountant, of the southern portion of the said block, containing 1,515 acres, more or less, for a term of 21 years, with a right of renewal for a further term of 21 years at a rental to be fixed by the meeting. Right to compensation for improvements effected by the lessee at end of first term of 21 years if renewal be not taken.)

(That part of the above block, containing 1 rood, be leased to Robert Sanders for 21 years, with a right of renewal for 21 years at a rental of £6 per annum for the first 21 years and 5 per cent. on the unimproved Government valuation for the renewed term, but not less than £6 per annum.)
26	4645	Waimana 1B 6B 2B ..	Kia whakaactia he riihi ki a John F. Boynton, o Waimana, tangata māhi paamu, mo nga tau e 21, i nga moni reti e 15s. i te eka i te tau. (That a lease be granted to John F. Boynton, of Waimana, farmer, for a term of 21 years at the rental of 15s. per acre per annum.)
27	4646	Kaitao-Rotohokahoka LN 2	Me hokona taua whenua ki a Thomas A. Turner, o Rotorua, tangata maki paamu, mo nga moni e rite ana ki te paanga o nga Maori i te warui tuturu a te Kawananatanga. (That the above block be sold to Thomas A. Turner, of Rotorua, farmer, for the amount of the Natives interest in the unimproved Government valuation thereof.)

28	4391	Rangitaiki 22F ..	Me whakaactia te riihi o taua poraka ki a William Henry Carter mo nga tau e rima ko te reti e £3 i te eka. Ko nga moni katoa o te riihi kia kotahi tonu te utunga a te kai-tango riihi. Ma te kai-tango riihi e utu nga reiti. Nga whakapainga tuturu katoa ma nga kai-rihi i te ma e mutu ai te riihi. Ko nga moni ruuri ma te moni reti kapenecheihana ranci o utu. Ko te moni reti mo te kotahi tau inaianei kei a kaata e pupuri me utu ki te Poari. (That a lease of the above block be granted to William Henry Carter for a term of five years at a rental of £3 per acre, lessee to pay whole rental for whole term in one sum; lessee to pay rates. All permanent improvements to be property of lessors at end of term. Survey costs to be paid out of rental or out of compensation. One year's rental at present held by Mr. Carter to be also paid into Board.)

Me whakaactia te tapahi-rakau ki a Walter Smith me Wharepapa Whatanui monga taua kotahi te tau apiti atu ki tetahi rima tau mehemea kaore e taea he tapahi o nga rakau i nga kotahi tekau tuatahi, ko te roireti 1/- ia rau putu me ata meiha; ko nga rakau katoa e hiahijatiaana hei hanga i nga whare ririki, i nga whare ranci o nga kai mahi, piriti me nga taramu raena kaua he utu; ko nga rangatira noona te whenua ka ahei noatu i te hoko paraki hei hanga whare i te waru hereni ia rau putu. (That timber-cutting rights be granted to Walter Smith and Wharepapa Whatanui for ten years, with a right renewal for five years if the timber thereon is not exhausted within the first ten years, at a royalty of 1s. per 100 superficial feet log measurement; that all timber required for mill-buildings, men's cottages, bridges, and tramline, be free of charge; that owners be supplied with second-class timber for building purposes at the rate of 8s. per 100 feet.)
