HE whakaatu atu tenei na te Poari Whenua Maori o te Takiwa o Tokerau ko nga huihuinga, i raro i nga tikanga o Wahi XVIII o te Ture Whenua Maori, 1909, o nga tangata no ratou nga whenua e mau nei i roto i te rarangi tuatahi o te Kupu Apiti i raro iho nei, ka tu ki nga kainga kua tuhia nei ki te rarangi tuarua, a nga ra me nga wa kua tuhia nei ki te rarangi tuatoru me te rarangi tuawha, ki te whiriwhiri i nga tikanga o nga motini e mau nei i roto i te rarangi tuarima o taua Kupu Apiti.
