Messrs. Ellis Bros.' team for the meeting will consist of Red Grouse, Blackstone, and Brighton.

At the Southland Racing Club's autumn meeting the totalisator turnover was £635 being the amount handled at the corresponding meeting at Invercargill.

Canteen and Vladimir are expected at Riccarton on Monday to fulfil their respective engagements at the Canterbury Jockey Club's autumn meeting.

Some of the Yaldhurst yearlings are now being put through their feelings. Among them are a half-sister of Victoria to Martian, and the Stennick Hermsdorf. The former is a big fine youngster, the latter a closely built colt that is likely to come to hand early.

The Canterbury Jockey Club has good reason to feel satisfied with the acceptances it has received for the Easter Handicap and Great Autumn Handicaps.

Night-horses remain in the short race and 15 in the Autumn Handicap, and of those the greater proportion are likely to see the post. It is supposed the entries created concerning the wonderful abilities of some of those further down the list, I have still a strong liking for Red Grouse for both races.

He is an improving horse, and will be with the best in the race to improve with age, they often develop into something very good indeed. Lady Lilian I have no fancy for, despite the fact that she keeps sound, but Vladimir is evidently coming to be well considered.

Pampero has only to be at his best to run a great race in the Easter Handicap, and we understand here that he is progressing satisfactorily.

Canteen is the best of the Easter Handicap, but if in the honour he should run prudently in the Autumn Handicap. Welbeck is brightening up, and beginning to exhibit some of his old brilliancy, but he will not be at the Easter Handicap, and moreover, he was sore after exercise yesterday.

Petrovna, who arrived at Riccarton on Wednesday, is in the best of her condition, remarking applies to Quarrystone and Canale Chief, since the former dismissed his connectives by showing signs of soreness after work on Thursday. I have good reports of Redwood, and he will be in the best of his condition.

The last named will probably be Mr. Stead's first string for the Easter Handicap, and the former for the Autumn Handicap, although I should not be surprised to see the latter in the Easter Handicap, if he is of quality, and has a better name.

ELLERSLIE TRAINING NOTES.

ELLERSLIE, Saturday.

Delphine and Bonour finished in front of Scuty at the end of a mile, the last 7 furlongs being run in 1.35. Almyred alone with a light weight up ran a mile in 1.44, the last gallop and the running. Helmer skipped over five furlongs in 1.58, beat Seaton early but Portland Lass at the end of five furlongs in 1.7.5. Love Link alone, ran four furlongs in 55. Muthama had Scotch as a companion over five furlongs, the last five run in 1.10. 4.0. Galleg with Gahnford up, and Romeo with the light weight Colton in the saddle broke away at the mile post, and kept company with about six furlongs, when Romeo had his companion in trouble, and broke up three miles with a good hold in 1.50. 4-5. beating Waleki by about five lengths.
