## BOTOBUA GOVERNMENT SANATORIUM.

The charge for admission to the Government Sanatorium at Rotorna is 30/ per week. The fee includes board and lodging, medical attendance, aursing, baths, and lana-dry. Owing to the accommodation being limited, and the great demand for beds, intending patients are advised to secure accommodation in advance. Patients recommended by Hospital or Charitable Aid Roards and members of duly registered Friendly Societies are admitted at 21, per week. To these patients are extended all the privileges given to those paying the bighter rate. Beds available for Friendly Society patients are limited to siz. The Government Baincologist, ARTHUR S. WOHLMANN, M.D., B.S. London, M.R.C.S., L.R.C.P., Eng., is in charge of the Government Baths and Sanatorium, and is swisted by WILLIAM B. URAIG, M.A., M.B., and C.M. (Ed.). Either of these medical officers may be consulted at the Sanatorium, or will, on request, attended at visitors' residences.

# TARAWERA-WAIMANGU TOUR.

Chief among the side-trips in the Rotorus District is that to Tarawers, Rotomahans, and the mammoth Waimangu Geyser. The coach route passes the beautiful Lakes of Thittapu and Rotokakahi, and terminates at the rained village of Wairoa, which was destroyed by the Taiawera eroption in 1886. Thence a Government of 1 launch coarers visitors across Lake Tarawera. Another hauch trip is made across Rotomahana ithe most wonderful lake in the worldi, where the excursionist boats over boiling water. Thence visitors walk to the Waimangu Geyser. LAKE WAIKAREMOANA.

Excellent troot fishing is to be had, and interesting excursions may be made on the lake and size to the low-by little neighbouring lake of Waikare-tit. Oil isanch and rowing boats. #### HANMER HOT SPRINGS.

Gevernment Spa at Hanner (altitude 1.213 feet), one day by rail and coach from Christchurch. Exceptionally due climate: clear, bright, and health-bringing. Gevernment Accommodation House. Excellent hot mineral curative baths, public and private. Hot-air and douche buths. Massage. The waters are efficacious in cases of rheomatism, scintica, gout, disorders of the stomach and liver, skin complaints, etc. Shooting and fishing in the acighbourhood.

#### LARE WARATIPU.

WAKATIPU, the most easily accessible of the great Southern Lakes, is one day's journey by train from Dunedin or Inverterryill. Lofty mountains ranging up to 9.000 feet in height surround the Lake. Government steamers; enchanting water excursions. Numerous interesting land trips; Alpine ascents. Lakes Wasaks and Hawes are reached by coach from Queenstown (Wakatipu). Excellent Deer Staiking around Hawes. Hotel accommodation at Queenstown and elsewhers.

### OVERLAND TO MILFORD SOUND.

The most magnificent walking tour in the world.
