It swept through part of a paddock of ryc grass, which was in stook, destroying it, and would have reached Mr. Hartland's residence. had it not been for the strenuous efforts of the -neighbours, the fiames being stopped within three chains of the house. Reports from Mokai state that the fine totara bush now being milled by the Taupo Totara Timber Company is in danger of being swept away, and unless the wind changes the isstruction will be very great. The Kiwitca County Council met at 9 o'clock on Feb. 15th, and sat for only two hours, to enable councillors to get home to protect their properties from the bush fires. Cr. Guthrie stated that in the Rushine district the fires had put back settlers twelve months in their work, great have being wrought. Moore's six-roomed house and outbuildings at Parapara have been completely destroyed. The fire swept in one sheet of flame from the greamery on the main South-rond, mop-ping up everything before it. The chairman of the County Council, who lives at Waitune, said his property was completely sur-rounded.
