

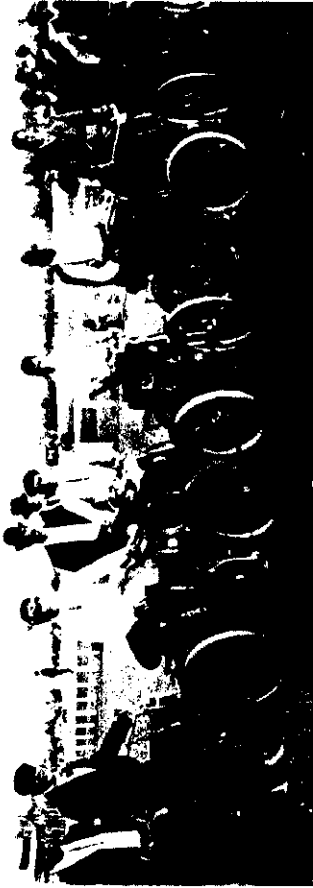
MOTOR-CYCLE RACE AT LEVIN.

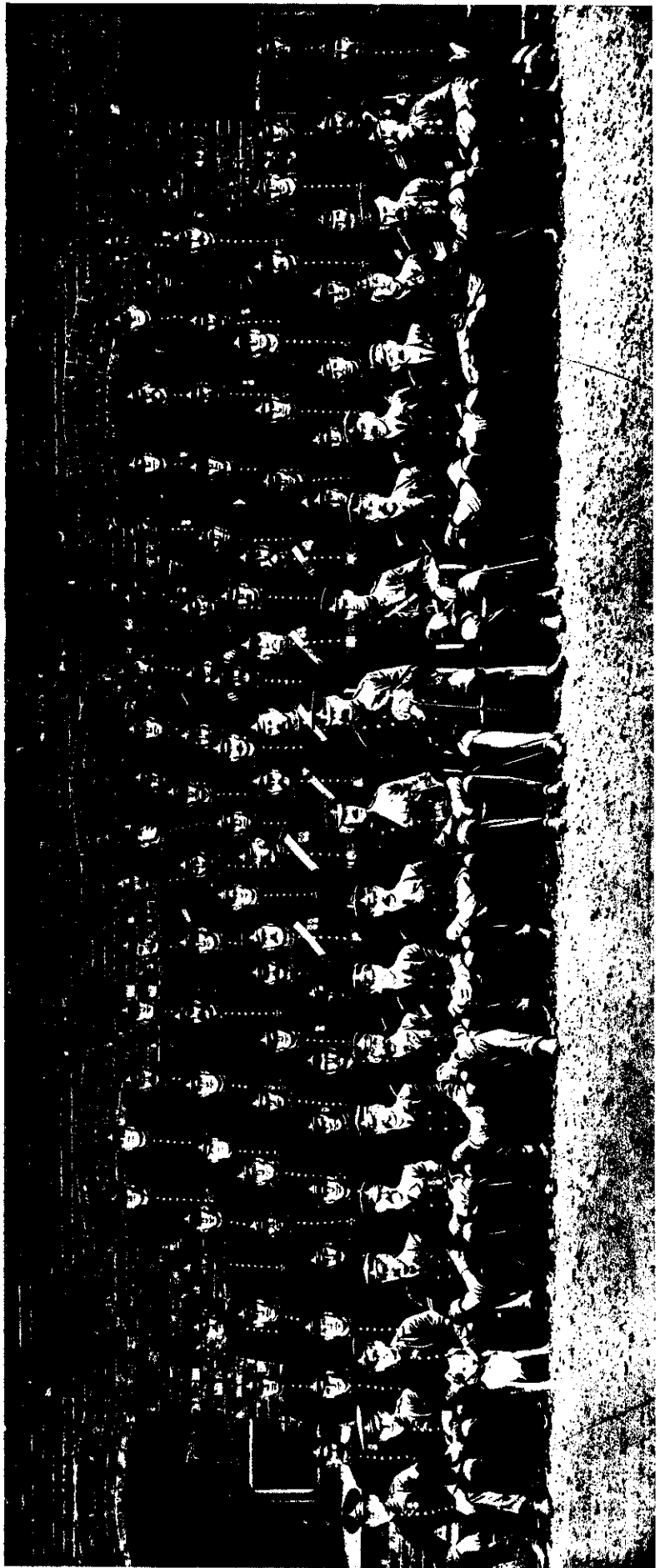
RETIREMENT OF SERGEANT-MAJOR GENTLES.
