

WHEN ROYALTY WEDS.


Mr. Walter Buchanan, of Auckland, has, by Royal command of His Majesty King George H. of Ponga, designed and built a cake for the coming nuprials of that Christian potentate, which has probably never had its peer in the anna's of Auckland cakes. It is a fruly dazzling creation, weighing 500ths, measuring lft across its base, and standing in its five thers, surmounted by the crown and bunquet, a full eight feet. The diminutive structure alongside is a wedding cake of ordinary dimensions.



OPENING THE NEW REMUERA SCHOOL.



The new public school in Market Road, Remenca, was opened on Saturday by the chairman of the Education Board, Mr. C. J. Parr. The new school, one of the flurest of its kind in New Zealand, cost £4,500 to creet, whilst the site was bought for £2,000. A memorial consisting of a bambone marble drlaking fountain, to the memory of the late Mr. R. R. Heriot, for Ty years headmaster of the school, was movelled by the Rev. W. Beatty.
