**THE TAVIUNI RE-LAUNCHED—A NOTABLE FEAT OF ENGINEERING.**

After being stranded for many months at the mouth of the Ingher River, the steamer Taviani has been successfully re-launched. It was found necessary by the engineers to build a caulis to hold the steamer, and this work was rendered very difficult on account of the shifting sands. The ship was finally "jacked" into position and hauled by powerful machinery down its position to the river. The work called for great ingenuity, skill and perseverance, and is to be numbered amongst the engineering feats of the Dominion. (1) The steamer coming through the caulis to the river.
