

A BURNING MOUNTAIN IN FULL BLAST.

Ngauruhoe (7.515 feet), the only active volcano in New Zealand, is one of the three magnifecent mountains that dominate the centre of the island, and anothed which the ancient Maori weaved many a poetic legend.
