Three divers did valuable work in connection with the salvage operations on the New Zealand Shipping Co.'s steamer 'Kaipara', which was stranded recently in the Rangitoto Channel. The divers were able to locate the damage to the ship's bottom, and also to plug up the hole, after which the water was pumped out of the hold, and the steamer was floated into Hobson's Bay, previous to being dacked and put in motion.
