



NEARING COMPLETION—AUCKLAND'S BIG FERRO-CONCRETE BRIDGE.

The big ferro-concrete bridge which spans the Cemetery Gully is now practically completed, and is already in use by foot passengers. The bridge provides a direct avenue from the city to the Domain, and has immensely improved the means of communication with some of the eastern districts. The view from the bridge is magnificent.
