

A MODERN DREDGER FOR GISBORNE.

The new dredger, Manl, built to the order of the Gisborne Harbour Board, arrived in Auckland on Sunday from Renfrew, where she was built. The vessel embodies all the latest improvements of her class, and came out to New Zeatand under the command of Capturn James Stewart. She left Renfrew on December 31, touching at Port Said, Colombo, Fremantle, and Melhourne, the Just-named port being cleared on March 20th. The dredger is to be docked for painting in Auckland, and thereafter will proceed to Gisborne, where she will be set to work at once.
