A PALACE ON WHEELS.

This luxurious railway saloon has been built at the works of the Metropolitan Amalgamated Railway Carriage and Wagon Company, Limited, Birmingham, for the Buenos Aires centenary exhibition. The coach has been constructed for the President, and is a gift from the company. The day saloon is furnished in white, with green silk panels, the style being that of Louis XVI. period. The bedroom is finished off most beautifully with a Tynecastle ceiling. The study is fitted with a handsome secretary bookcase. The saloon contains two bathrooms, fitted with marble wash-basins. It is probably the most beautiful railway saloon in the world, and far surpasses any royal carriage. It was inspected by Lord Chamberlain at the special request of His Majesty.
