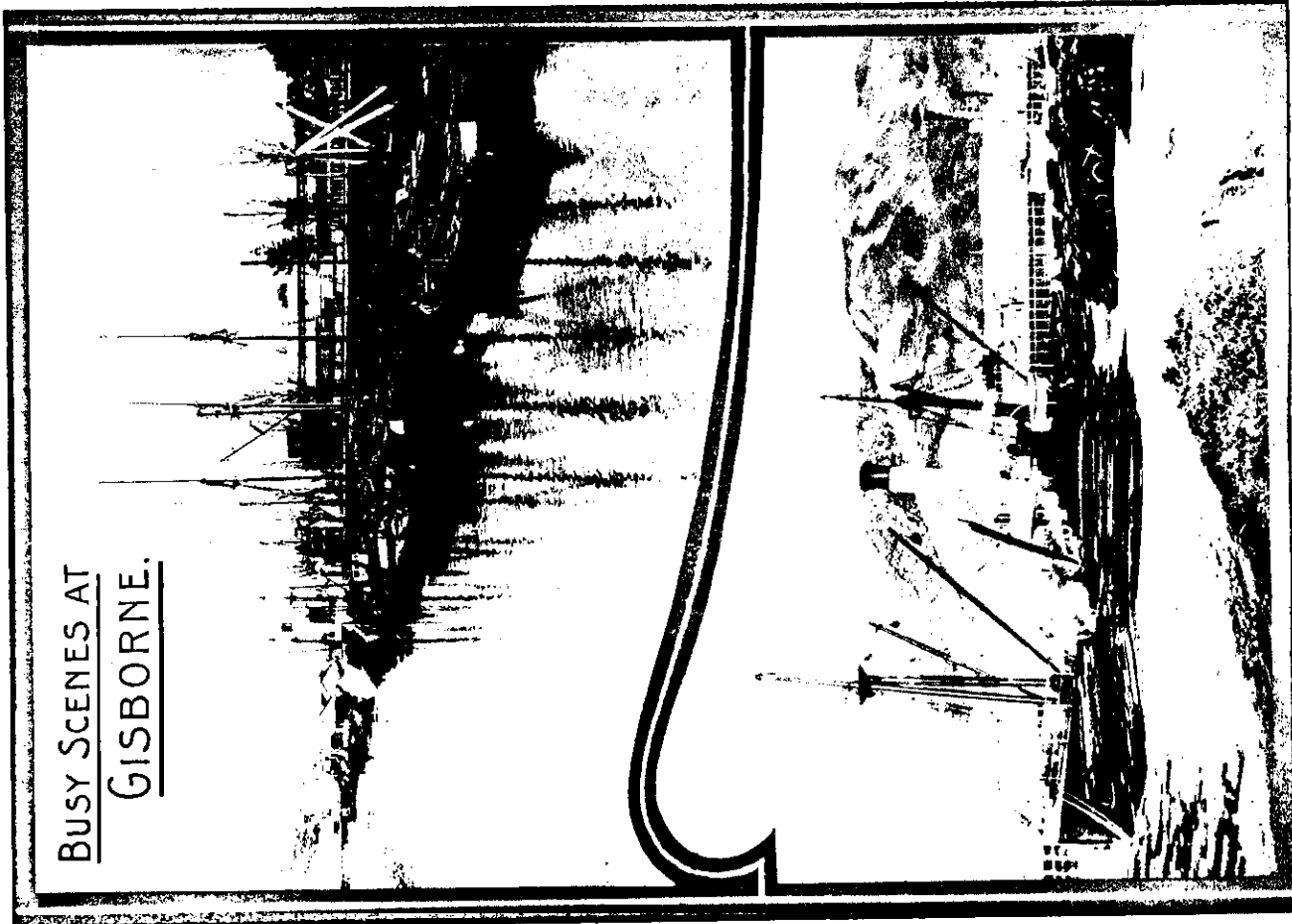


MODERN HARBOUR IMPROVEMENTS IN AUCKLAND.
