

A FINE FLIGHT BY AIRSHIP

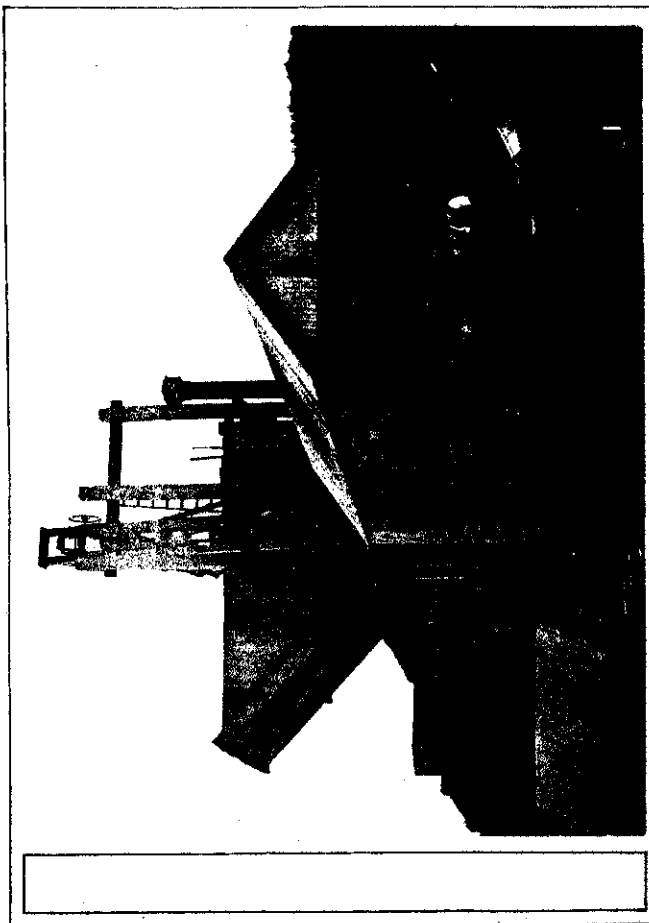
