

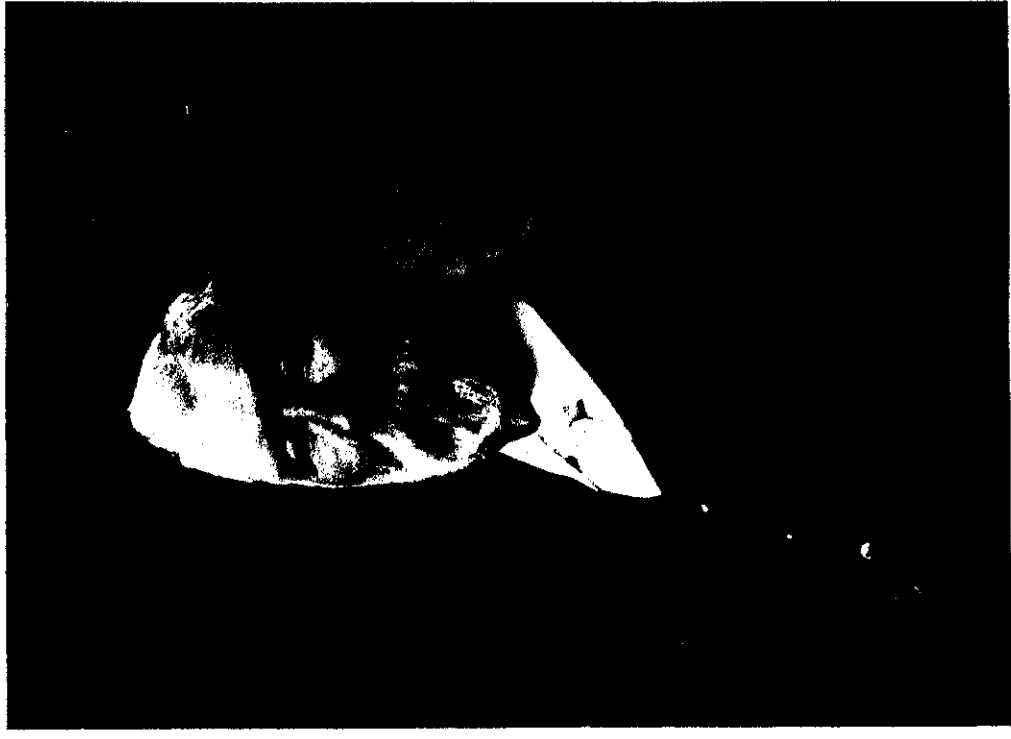

He filled several important positions in Melbourne, New Zealand, and Wanganui, where he remained until 1905, when he received his present appointment. The Bank of Australasia was incorporated by Royal Charter in 1825, and has branches in all the States of the Commonwealth and in New Zealand.

Mr Ewen Alexander Campbell, Chairman and Managing Director of the Wanganui Freezing Company, was born on May 27, 1843, in Wanganui. His father was Captain M. Campbell, of the 2nd Regiment. Mr Campbell was educated at the Wanganui Freezing Company, and his father was the late Mr. Campbell, who was the manager of the plant. He has been in the plant since 1880, and has since been extended until it now has a capacity of 3000 per day. Attached to the freezing works is an up-to-date fellmongery, manure factory, and tanning plant.
