## UNVEILING THE MEMORIAL TO THE GREAT WHITE QUEEN.

King George, on May 16th, in the presence of the German Emperor and Empress. Queen Mary and many members of the Royal family, unveiled the great memorial to Queen Victoria before Euckligham Palace. The accasion was marked by soleum religious eccemonies, commeted by the Archbishop of Canaerbury, and an imposing military display.
