FEILDING, AN IMPORTANT WEST COAST CENTRE, AND SEVENTH LARGEST INLAND TOWN IN THE DOMINION.

The distributing point of a thelying district in Weilington province, Feliding is one of the best labeled towns in New Zealand, provision—being made for squares and streets, varying from 66 to 100 feet wide, by the Colonist Lami and Loan Corporation, an English company that originally developed the township and district.
