FEILDING, AN IMPORTANT WEST COAST CENTRE, AND SEVENTH LARGEST INLAND TOWN IN THE DOMINION.

The distributing point of a thriving district in Wellington province, Feilding is one of the best laid-out towns in New Zealand, provision being made for squares and streets, varying from 60 to 100 feet wide, by the Colonist Land and Loan Corporation, an English company that originally developed the township and district.
