


GREAT PANAMA CANAL NEARING COMPLETION—ONE OF THE ENORMOUS LOCKS.

According to the reports of the U.S. Government engineers the long dreamed of waterway through the Panaua Isthmus will be ready for traffic eighteen months before the official opening, which has been fixed for January 1st, 1915.
