FROM NAPIER TO WAIH! AND FURTHER BY RAIL-IN A FEW YEARS MORE OR LESS.

The first sod of the Napier to Gisborne rullway was turned last week by the Premier. Sir Joseph Ward, at Westshore, Napier, and enthusiasm. This is part of the great East Coast line which has been already started at Gisborne, and Tauranga with an unfulfilled promise of gnother start at the Walth end. From Napier to Gisborne the line will east about £1.25000, and the entire length to Walth land £3.000,000. In an optimistic speech the Prime Minister said "Before many years are passed you will be able to take train from Napier, and go not only to Gisborne, but to the whole of the important towns in the North Island, including Auckland."
