

"ALL TOGETHER, BOYS!"-AUSTRIANS "ROLLING" A HUGE SPIT INTO THE "FACE."

This co-operative method of loosening a ton or so at a time saves the cumning Austrian much weavying digging off his own but -or rather spade.



The Austrians in the far North bave hit on a far better method of obtaining gain than the ordinary process of digging. They have erected an oil eagine and pump, which keeps the "face" of their digging quite day, and at the same time gives a plentful supply of water for washing the gain from soil, etc. By this means they are able to work to a depth of eight or ten feet in comfort.
