"THREE CHEERS"—AN INCIDENT OF THE LABOURERS' STRIKE IN AUCKLAND.

While the pickets were busy with the men engaged on the street-paving works in Fort Street throughout the lunch hour, large crowds watched the proceedings with evident interest.
