

AN UNBEATEN CREW-NORTH SHORE HEAVY-WEIGHT MAIDENS,

The North Shore heavy mablen crew has had an undefeated record during the rowing senson just ended, beginning at Russell, and continuing with unbroken success in open matchen events at Whangarel, Mercer, Ngaruawatin, and Rotorna. At Whangarel it carried off the Steadman Cup, and at Rotorna the Dowar Shiebl, which is valued at 100. At Russell and at Rotorna the crew was steered by P. Spraggon, and at the other regulates by A.
