All nominations, acceptances, and entries, accompanied by the necessary amounts, must be addressed to the Secretary, and left at the Secretary's Office, Brougham Street. New Plymouth, not later than 9 p.m. on the advertised dates of closing. Full particulars of colours, age, and pedigree must be forwarded with the nominations.

In all cuses where penulties have to be carried for winning, it shall be the duty of the owner, trainer, or jockey to notify like Secretary on or before Tuesday, February 18th, 1896.

Five per cent will be deducted from all winnings towards the expenses of the course.

All races to be run under the Rules of Racing as adopted by the Metropolitan Clubs of New Zealand.
