Coursing Notes.

FOLLOWING up my review of last season's coursing, the first I have on my list this week is Guy Fawkes, a white and brindle dog, the property of Mr C. Whitten. At the opening of last season's coursing Guy was looked upon as a likely stake winner, but unfortunately was troubled with inflammation of the kidneys, and consequently was only able to win a supplementary stake. To the critical eye, Guy looks all over a Waterloo candidate, and it is to be hoped by the time he is wanted that he will have completely recovered from his complaint, and that his owner may yet see him "fit and well." Dogs beaten by Guy Fawkes were Port Admiral, Sir Robert, Ocean Boy, and Pat My next is Snowdonia, a black and white bitch the property of Mr M. Freney. She started on two occasions last year, and although she ran with great dash in her first course, she failed in her second try and never had the luck to see the end of any card. Snowdonia is a well built bitch, having plenty of propelling power, which is one really good point in her favour. Dogs beaten by her were Rebel, Rover, Hilda, Pat, and Spring. One of the most brilliant dogs to look at last season was the white dog, White Hind (Cardock—Cerito), the property of Mr Stevenson. He is always very keen, always on the alert for his game. His two wins last season were the New Lynn Maiden and Supplementary Stakes. Dogs beaten by White Hind were Boojum, Blue Light, Guy Fawkes, Rockball, Fiend, and Evening Star.

A scientific exhibition of boxing, wrestling, and club-swinging will shortly be given in Auckland by Herb McKell, champion light-weight boxer of Australia. Limited bouts will take place between local amateurs for trophies, and a well-known heavy-weight will undertake to stop four rounds in front of McKell. Professor Starlight, middle-weight champion of Australia, arrived on Tuesday, and will take part at McKell's performance.
