SUMMER MEETING.

FIRST DAY.—BOXING DAY, DECEMBER 26TH, 1892.

TRIAL STAKES of 80 sovs.; second horse to receive 10 sovs. out of the stakes. Entrance 2 sovs. each, to go to the funds. Weight for age. For three-year-olds and upwards. Maidens, if three-year-olds, allowed 5lbs.; four-year-olds, 10lbs.; five-year-olds and upwards, 14lbs. One mile and a distance.

THE GREAT NORTHERN FOAL STAKES of 300 sovs., added to a sweepstake of 10 sovs. each; 5 sovs. ft. or no liability if declared by 8 o'clock on the night of general entry. The second horse to receive 50 sovs. and the third horse 25 sovs. from the stakes. For two-year-olds. Colts, 8st 10lb; fillies, 8st 5lb; geldings allowed 5lbs. The forfeit (5 sovs.) to be declared and paid to the A.R.C. Secretary by 12 noon on the day before the race, or the nominator will be liable for the whole stake—10 sovs. Closed. Six furlongs.

THE AUCKLAND CUP (Handicap) of 600 sovs., added to a sweepstake of 10 sovs. each; second horse to receive 100 sovs. and third horse 25 sovs. out of the stakes. Entrance 2 sovs., and acceptance 3 sovs. each, to go to the funds. For three-year-olds and upwards. Sweep to be paid half-an-hour before the race. Two miles.

HANDICAP HURDLE RACE of 150 sovs.; second horse to receive 20 sovs. out of the stakes. Entrance 1 sov., and acceptance 2 sovs. each, to go to the funds. Over 8 flights of hurdles. Two miles.

RAILWAY HANDICAP of 100 sovs.; second horse to receive 10 sovs. out of the stakes. Entrance 1 sov., and acceptance 1 sov. each, to go to the funds. For three-year-olds and upwards. Three-quarters of a mile.

NURSEY HANDICAP of 80 sovs.; second horse to receive 10 sovs. out of the stakes. For two-year-olds. Entrance 1 sov., and acceptance 2 sovs. each, to go to the funds. Winner of Great Northern Foal Stakes to carry 10lbs. extra. Five furlongs.

MAIDEN STEEPLECHASE of 100 sovs.; second horse to receive 15 sovs., and third horse 5 sovs. out of the stakes. Entrance 1 sov., and 2 sovs. each at the post, to go to the funds. For all horses that have never won a steeplechase value 50 sovs. Four-year-olds to carry 10st; five-year-olds 11st; six years and aged, 12st. About three miles.

CHRISTMAS HANDICAP of 100 sovs.; second horse to receive 10 sovs. out of the stakes. Entrance 1 sov., and acceptance 1 sov. each, to go to the funds. For three-year-olds and upwards. Winner of any handicap after the publication of the weights to carry 5lbs. penalty. One mile and a quarter.

NEWMARKET HANDICAP of 100 sovs.; second horse to receive 10 sovs. out of the stakes. Entrance 1 sov., and acceptance 1 sov. each, to go to the funds. For three-year-olds and upwards. Six furlongs.

GREAT NORTHERN DERBY of 500 sovs., added to a sweepstake of 15 sovs. each; 5 sovs. forfeit or no liability if declared to the Secretary by 8 o'clock p.m. on the night of general entry. Second horse to receive 100 sovs. and third horse 25 sovs. out of the stakes. For three-year-olds. Colts, 8st 10lb; fillies and geldings, 8st 5lb. The forfeit—5 sovs.—to be declared and paid to the A.R.C. Secretary by 12 noon on the day before the race, or the nominator will be liable for the whole stake. Closed. One mile and a half.

MIDSUMMER HANDICAP of 150 sovs.; second horse to receive 15 sovs., and third horse 5 sovs. out of the stakes. For two-year-olds. Entrance 2 sovs. and acceptance 3 sovs. each, to go to the funds. Five furlongs.

COUNTY HANDICAP of 75 sovs. Entrance 1 sov., and acceptance 1 sov. each, to go to the funds. For three-year-olds and upwards. Winner to be sold by auction immediately after the race, and the whole of the proceeds to go to the funds. One mile.

Entrance 2 sovs., and 3 sovs. at the post each, to go to the funds. Winner of the Canterbury Cup or Derby, or of the Auckland Derby, to carry 7lbs. extra, or of two of these races 10lbs. extra. Or any weight-for-age race of 200 sovs. 5lbs. extra. One mile and a half.

AUCKLAND STEEPLECHASE HANDICAP of 300 sovs., added to a sweepstake of 5 sovs. each; second horse to receive 50 sovs. and third horse 10 sovs. out of the stakes. Entrance 2 sovs. and acceptance 3 sovs. each, to go to the funds. About three miles and a half.

Those got by stallions or out of mares that have never produced a winner, at time of starting, allowed 5lbs. Maiden two-year-olds at time of starting to be allowed 5lbs. in addition to the breeding allowance. Maiden three-year-olds at time of starting allowed 10lbs. Entrance 2 sovs. and 2 sovs. each at the post, to go to the funds. Six furlongs.

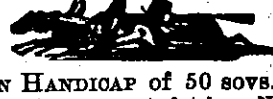
