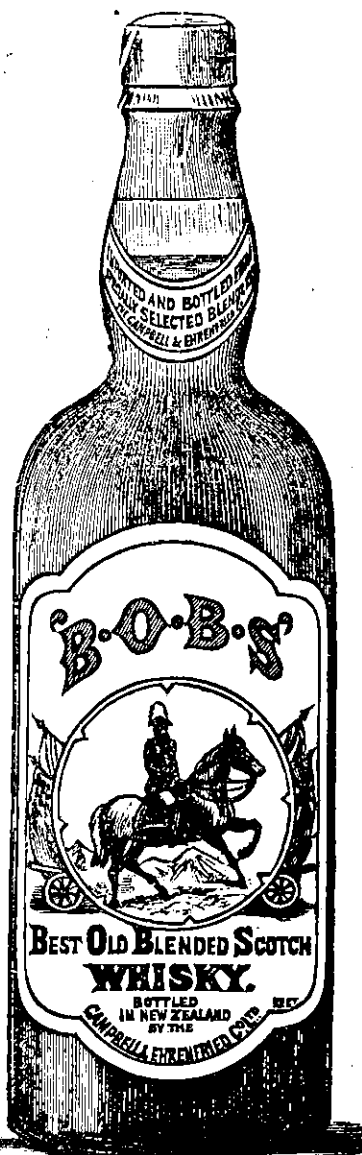

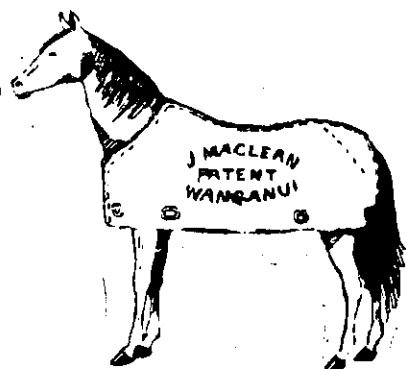

There is nothing to cause abrasions, nor can the Cover be displaced, the give and take being only about five inches.
