The half-sister (by St. Ambroise) to Bunyan, which Mr. F. Preston bought whilst attending the Cup meeting, is a very fine looking filly. She looks like one that would be fit to race earlier than her helt best her half-brother, whom she much resembles in many ways.

Nightmare, the sister to The Lark and Polycaste, is amongst the acceptors for the Hack Flying at Feilding. If this mare does not possess a lot of pace, then

her looks belie her greatly. Kremlin and Wirral are both said to have broken down.

Armistice, Helen Portland, and Guiding Step are being treated to a short spell. All going well the former will be taken to Auckland for the Cup race, in which she ought to have a good chance with only 7.12 on her back if she is fit on the day.

Irish Rifle is now being trained by Walter Raynor. The Musketry gelding looks in excellent nick, and should pick up a stake at Feilding.

Since he came back from Christehurch Maniapoto has been doing good work, and is expected to be a much improved horse at Feilding than he was at the Cup meeting.

Great interest is being taken in the Feilding Stakes, in which event Fleetfoot, Armlet and Lord Soult will in all probability meet again. It will be remembered that the three finished first, second and third in the Electric Plate at Riccarton. Next Friday's race will be over five instead of four furlongs. What difference the extra furlong will make is hard to say. Bunyan, the Wanganui Guineas winner, will also be a starter, I understand, as well as Elevation and Little Mary (the Merriwee filly, who is very speedy).

The acceptances received are large, and every event on the programme will probably be contested by a big field, whilst the class of horses en-gaged will be of the best.
