

speed. Leaside galloped a mile. Sweet Angelus could have easily defeated The Seer over a 5 furlongs' run in 1min 44-5sec. Lady Medalist and Latchet were well matched in a spin over half a mile run in 50 3-5sec. St. Joe and Ruapehu together traversed a mile and a quarter in 2min 15 1/2 sec.

After breakfast the two-year-olds were sprinted from the barrier on the course proper. The first pair to get going was Daybeam and Renigal who ran down from a flying start, the first named finishing a couple of lengths in front. Provocation had Expansion easily beaten over half a mile which he ran without a barrier start in 51 1-5sec, finishing under a strong pull. Broadsword defeated Applegarth and Somersault, running the distance in 49 3-5sec, finishing well. Caspian defeated Cronstadt and the Gaulus—Restive filly in 52 sec. Perle d'Or, who started with them was not seriously persevered with, but apparently held his companions safely throughout and would have finished in front had his rider desired. Cymbiform defeated Boutade, Sergevitch and Alma, his time being 52sec.

Elysian, fully extended, completed distance in 49 3-5sec. Nautiform and Ristori who started with him were eased up after going three furlongs at which point Elysian appeared to have them both in difficulties. Fasnakole and Sharpshooter finished together in front of Kilwinning. Laiglon, Taskmaster and Thistle-down in 51sec. Master Leslie assisted by Alexis over the last four furlongs ran a mile in 2min 48 2-5sec, while Don Orsiro ran a similar distance in 1min 26sec. Passion defeated Merry Lass in a spin over six furlongs, while Tessera, Fancy Free, Cingalee and the Jane Eyre colt were well matched at the end of a fast half mile. Several others performed and Diabolo galloped a mile, the last six furlongs of which occupied 1min 22 1-5sec, and the pair finished together, but Diabolo had his companion well beaten. Apa traversed a mile and a half on the grass at three-quarter speed, while Frisco bowled along freely over two circuits at half and three-quarter speed. Ambrosian and Lady Lucy brushed over half a mile, finishing together. Playmate defeated Waimaria with ridiculous ease in a spin over a mile on the tan. Lady Medalist was going better than Hatchet the end of a strongly run half mile, which occupied 53 1/2 secs. Others performed light tasks, while a number were restricted to useful tasks, including Reserved, Truthful, Grovanne and Ganton.

Monday.—On Monday rain overnight made the tracks somewhat heavy and proceedings were uninteresting. Penates ran six furlongs on the tan in 1min 19 3-5sec, moving freely. Gold Crest with Gipsy Belle for a companion, brushed over half a mile in 51 1-5 sec., finishing strongly and well. All Red and Diabolo galloped a mile, the last six furlongs of which occupied 1 min. 22 1-5 sec., and the pair finished together, but Diabolo had his companion well beaten. Apa traversed a mile and a half on the grass at three-quarter speed, while Frisco bowled along freely over two circuits at half and three-quarter speed. Ambrosian and Lady Lucy brushed over half a mile, finishing together. Playmate defeated Waimaria with ridiculous ease in a spin over a mile on the tan. Lady Medalist was going better than Hatchet at the end of a strongly run half mile, which occupied 63 1/2 secs. Others performed light tasks, while a number were restricted to walking exercises. The recent arrivals, Gold Thread, Gold Lace, and Gold Treasure, were out, and did steady pacing.

TUESDAY.

Perfect weather prevailed when training operations commenced on Tuesday morning, and some smart

gallops were put up, especially by the Cup and Stewards' candidates. Ruapehu was first out, and ran a mile and a quarter in 2 min. 15 2-5 sec. Stratagem and Glenculloch covered the same distance in 2 min. 12 4-5 sec., the Cup candidate moving in good style. Cavatina and Tsitsibar cut out eight furlongs in 1 min. 47 sec. Petrovna and Balaclava finished together over six furlongs in 1 min. 16 sic., Silk Web joining in the last three furlongs. Whistlecraft was too good for Husbandman over a mile, run in 1 min. 44 2-5 sec. A good gallop. Leonardo and Oasis finished together over a mile and a quarter in 2 min. 21 sec. Muskatoon did a good working gallop. Makura beat Sea Girl over six furlongs, the last four taking 50 sec. Glenullin easily defeated Tangimoana and Riflemaid over a mile and a quarter, run in 2 min. 15 sec., the first mile taking 1 min 48 sec. Flitaway and Sister Anne were associated in a five furlong flutter from a standing start, the former winning easily in 1 min, 2 1-5 sec.—a very smart performance. Tremulous was too good for Contender over six furlongs, run in 1 min. 17 sec. North Head galloped six furlongs alone. Harvester covered a mile, the last seven furlongs taking 1 min. 33 sec. Inch Bonny beat Eagleston over six furlongs. Vasa had Rose Noble and Gold Treasure well beaten in a seven furlong go, run in 1 min. 33 sec. Prim cut out seven furlongs in 1 min. 28 1-5 sec. Master Soult finished in front of Dawn over six furlongs, the last five of which took 1 min. 3 sec. Moloch, striding out in much better style, beat Signor and Uhlando over twelve furlongs, run in 2 min. 31 sec., the last ten furlongs taking 2 min 15 sec. Penates defeated Naumal over six furlongs in 1 min. 16 2-5 sec. Gipsy Belle, with a light weight up, beat Gold Crest over six furlongs, run in 1 min. 16 sec., the latter galloping well. Probable, with sweater on and striding out freely, beat Lapland over twelve furlongs in 2 min. 17 2-5 sec.

Master Delaval, Zimmerman, and Grand Slam, covered a mile and a half, the last ten furlongs taking 2 min. 13 sec. There was very little between the top-weights, but Grand Slam was badly beaten. Heorthen easily beat Downfall, Apa, and St Joe, in that order, in a solidly run mile and a-half, in 2 min. 39 sec., Heorthen finishing up strongly. The first four furlongs was run in 51 2-5 secs., six furlongs in 1 min. 18 sec. and the mile in 1 min. 45 sec. Vladimir defeated All Guns in a six furlong flutter, run in 1 min. 17 sec., the last four furlongs taking 51 2-5 sec. Lupulite was much too good for Sea King over four furlongs, run in 50 sec. An interesting set-to over a mile and a half between All Red, White Lie, and Mahuta resulted in White Lie winning comfortably in 2 min. 38 sec., after getting badly left at the start. This was the best gallop of the morning. Pellicle and St. Aidan spurted over four furlongs.

Bobrikoff beat Count Witte by a neck over five furlongs, run in 1 min. 2 sec. Armamento and Saga covered a mile and a quarter. Moriarty cut out four furlongs in 52 1-5 sec. Leaside ran a mile in 1 min. 48 2-5 sec. Sun Bonnet was too good for Tiptoe over six furlongs, run in 1 min. 16 sec. Bonny Glen spurted four furlongs in 49 sec. Playmate and Waimaria were associated once round over the hurdle course, the former giving the best display.

Frisco covered two circuits alone, the first round easy, the last ten furlongs in 2 min. 15 1-5 sec., and the mile and a-half in 2 min. 43 sec. Gold Thread finished in front of Gold Lace over six furlongs, run in 1 min. 16 sec. The Seer beat Pronun over five furlongs, run in 1 min. 4 sec. Master Leslie, accompanied by Alexis over the last four furlongs, ran a mile and a quarter in 2 min. 13 sec. Passion and Merry Lass finished together at the end of a mile, the last seven furlongs taking 1 min. 29 1/2 sec; Farley Grove was tailed off.

Bautade was the first of the two-year-olds to come down the course proper, running four furlongs in 52 1-5 sec. Love Wisely and Equivocate were sent a good working gallop on the course proper. Broad Sword cut four furlongs out in 49 1-5 sec. Ambrosian finished second, and Taskmaster, Hatchet, Lady Medalist, and Thistle-down were strung in that order. Perle d'Or had the best of Day Beam, Merigal, and Solano over the same distance, run in 50 1-5 sec. Provocation beat Elysian comfortably over three furlongs, run round the course proper. Cymbiform won easily from Sergevitch in 51 sec. After giving some trouble at the post, jumping into Cronstadt, Nautiform just beat Expansion in 49 3-5 sec. Caspian and the Restive filly were not ridden out. Applegarth beat Somersault, L'Aiglon, and Fasnakyle in 49 4-5 sec., finishing strongly. Northern Star and Tessera negotiated a round over sticks, both jumping well.
