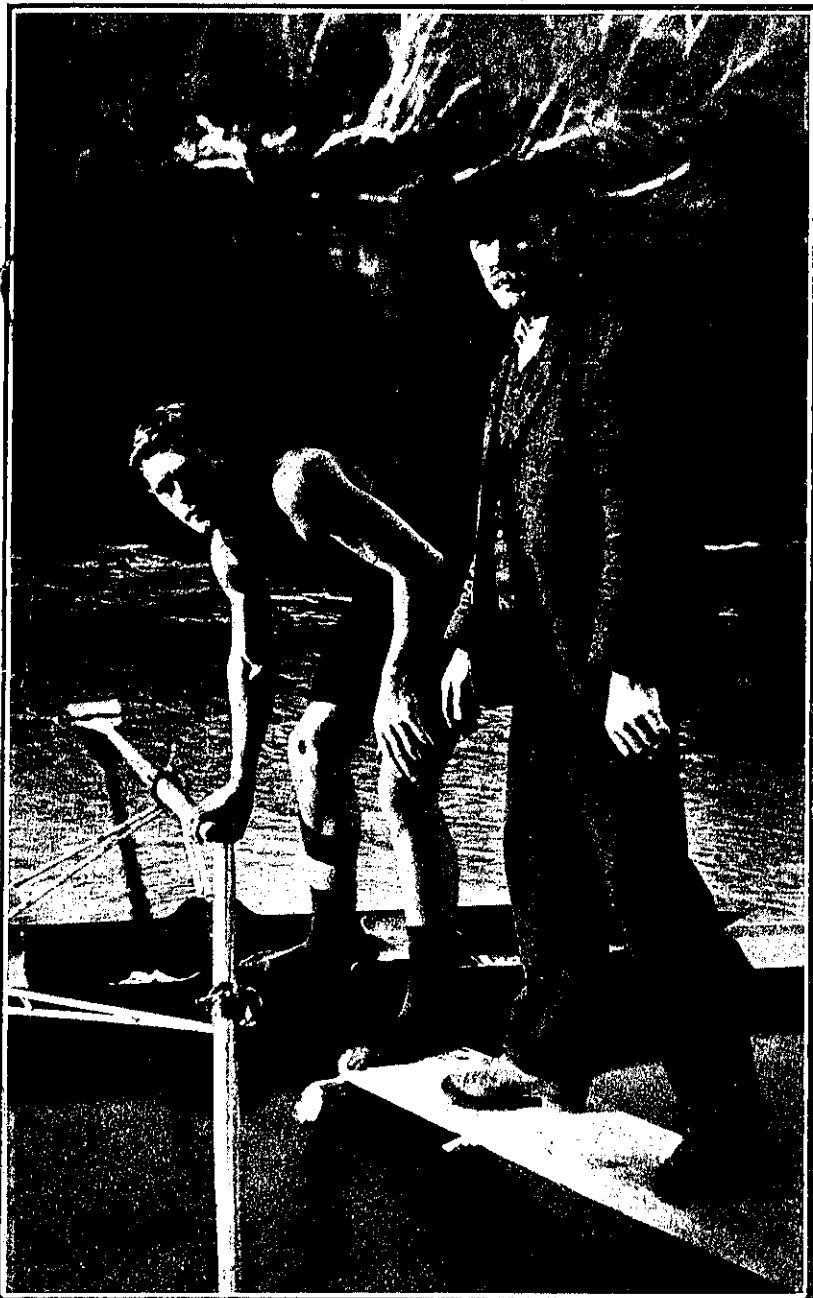


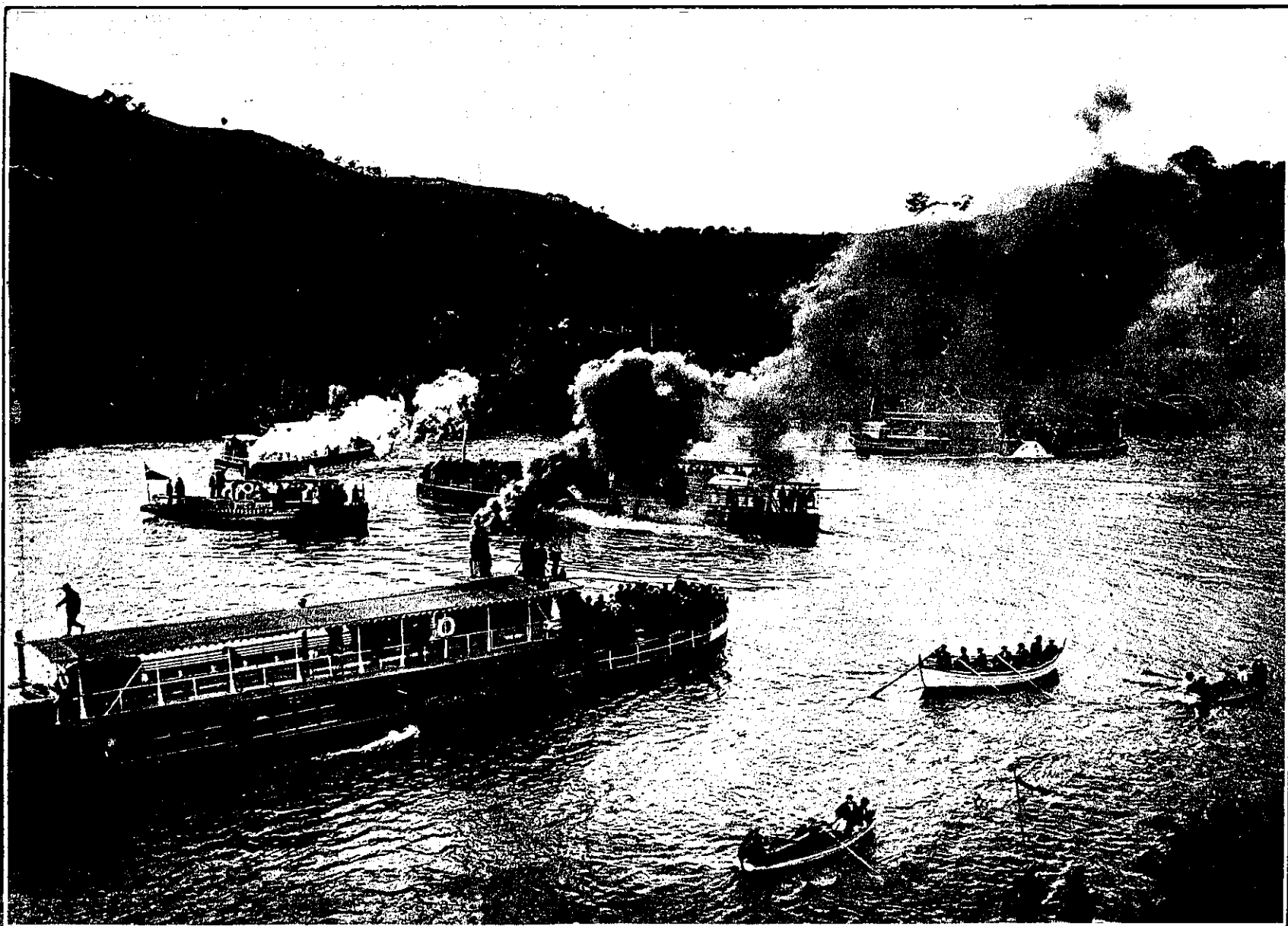
WORLD'S SCULLING CHAMPIONSHIP.
