

SECOND DAY.

EMPERADOR WINS JACKSON STAKES.

The meeting was concluded on Saturday in fine weather and before another large attendance. The totalisator handled £29,991 10s., as against £30,294 on the second day last year. The total for the meeting was £57,158, as against £57,201 for the corresponding meeting in 1914. The results were:—

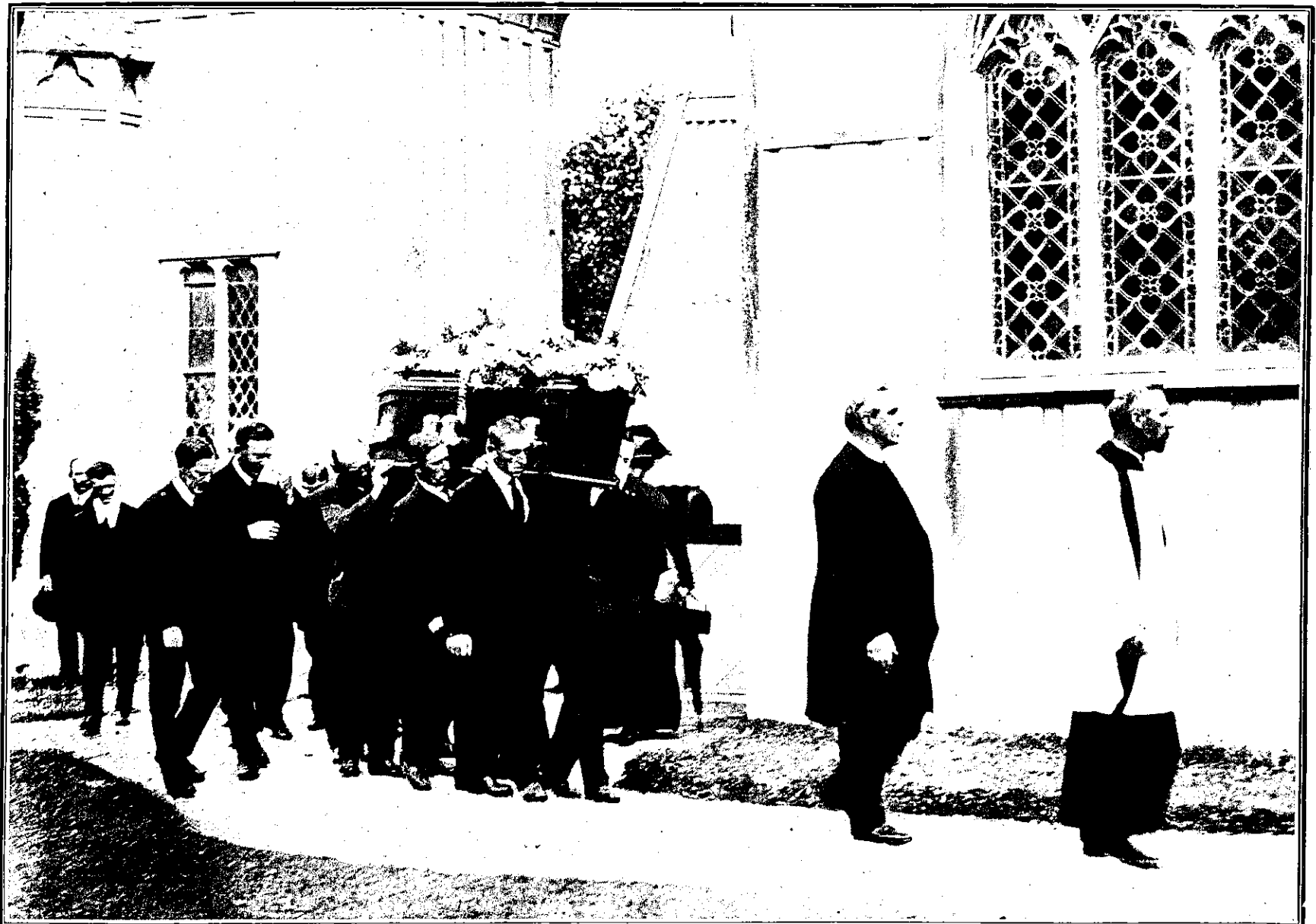
