

ECHOES OF THE WAR.

The speed with which Sheffield is supplying material for the navy and the army is unprecedented. Flames, steam and smoke leaving the chimneys of a long line of huge works are all that is seen of the greatest naval armoury in the world. The delicacy of the work turned out has never been surpassed. The quality of the steel is one of the most important and material factors that will decide the issue of the war, and it is a comforting reflection that England has a far larger capacity and better facilities for the execution of this high task than Germany. Sheffield is getting rather tired of the swaggering bluster of the panegyrists of Essen and Charlottenburg. Krupps never have been and can never hope to be, equal to Sheffield craft of the naval armourer. The drilling machines of the armament factory, rolling mills which smooth out the raw steel into armour plate, hydraulic pressures which squeeze 100-ton ingots into guns, 10-fathom oil tanks in which the ordnance is dipped for tempering, mammoth travelling cranes with Herculean lifting power, and blast furnaces which throw a blood-red glare on the screen of night—all are performing prodigies of well ordered strength.

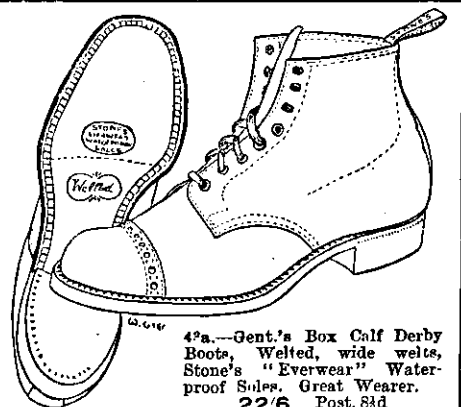

¶ We have just converted a pin-fire Gun to central fire. This is the third converted in as many weeks. It was originally a flint fire muzzle-loader converted to cap fire, then made a breech-loading pin-fire. Now we have it converted to a central fire breech-loader. This gun must be fully 70 to 80 years old.

¶ First-class Gunsmiths are retained by us. They can "brown" and "blue" black barrels, take dents out of barrels, re-stock, and tighten up breech so that there is no shake—in fact, make an old gun new. These Gunsmiths, being always on the spot, enable prompt execution of Repairs. Better work could not be done in England.
