



¶ We have just converted a pin-fire Gun to central fire. This is the third converted in as many weeks. It was

originally a flint fire muzzle-loader converted to cap fire, then made a breech-loading pin-fire. Now we have it converted to a central fire breech-loader. This gun must be fully 70 to 80 years old.
