Mark your envelope "Competition" in the top left-hand corner. All attempts must arrive on or before Thursday, September 9th, 1915.

£10 10s. will be awarded by the Editor of "Sporting and Dramatic Review" to the sender of the line which is considered to be the best by the adjudicators, by whom originality of idea will be taken into consideration. £5 5s. will be awarded to the sender of the next best line, and the senders of the next five best lines received will each be awarded £1 1s.

If there are more senders than one of a line that is selected by the adjudicators, the prize awarded for such

line will be divided equally amongst all the competitors who send in that line. The winning attempts will be selected by the Editor of "Sporting and Dramatic Review," who will be assisted by competent judges.

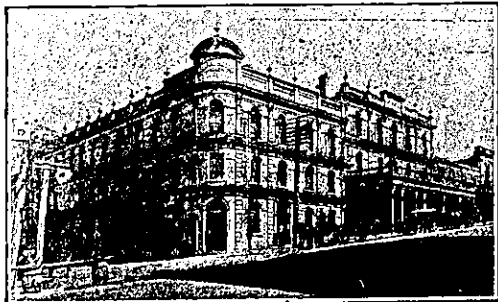

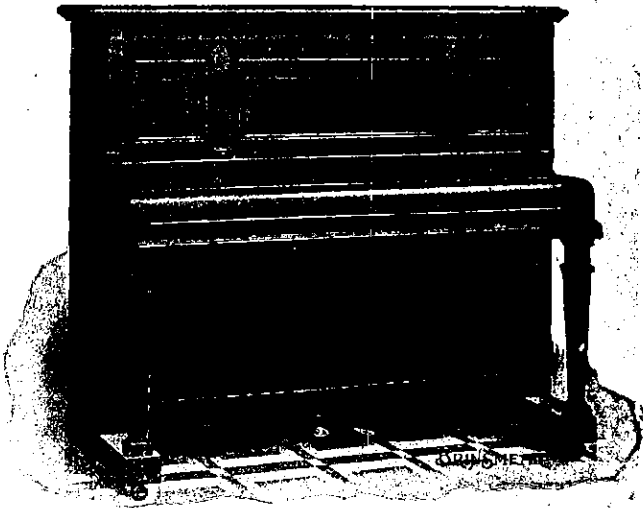
