Such entry must be made before 7 p.m. on the day on which the horse was placed except in the case of the third day of the Summer Meeting, for which such additional entries must be made before 7 p.m. on the second day of the meeting.

The Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry and to exclude any person or persons from the ground without giving any explanation.
