10. Nominations must state the bona fide owner of the horse.
11. No jockey will be allowed to ride or drive unless in full jockey's colours and breeches. (Rule 226.)

12. Any jockey not weighing out within ten minutes after ringing of bell, or not returning saddle cloths immediately at conclusion of events, will be fined £1, which will be strictly enforced. forced.

13. All protests must be made in writing, and accompanied by a fee of £5, to be forfeited if the protest is dis-£5, to b missed.

f5, to be forfeited if the protest is dismissed.

14. All protests must be in the hands of the Secretary within ten minutes after the decision of the race.

15.
