Royal Lupin, a half brother to the useful Coleraine, jumped four of the big battens slowly. He showed aptitude.

The bout of the morning was accomplished by the runner-up in last year's Great Northern Hurdle Race, Tragedy King, assisted by his stable mate Soultikoff over seven of the big battens. The first-named jumped splendidly.

Te Onga, Taihape and Ngatua hopped over three hurdles, taking the sod wall double and stone wall, the two latter taking the water jump, while Te Onga joined them at the stone wall. The fencing was one of the best efforts of the session. There was a margin in favour of the Regal gelding.

Master Regal, which has Wanganui engagements, put in two good circuits on the tan. The son of Regal leaves shortly for Wanganui.

Captain Jack, Lady Sabretache, Captain Lock and Waimai started over three of the big hurdles, taking the sod wall double jump and stone wall. Lady Sabretache slipping past the wing of the second fence of the double, while Captain Lock pulled up. Three more hurdles were negotiated, Mollyhawk joining in at the top of the straight, leading and taking the water jump, the others going over the double. They all finished over the stone wall.

Hopye and Tangahere, a hunter, started at the double jump, which found the latter out. She fell and on being remounted led her companion over the sod wall double and stone wall, making a good showing.

Dewy Morn and Genevieve were given a jumping lesson over the pony hurdles and one of the big schooling battens. Both showed good improvement since last facing the timber.

Goldmount, which has been off the scene for quite a considerable time, was given a run over a few of the pony hurdles and showed proficiency at the game. The golden chestnut is a good sort, and may be useful if he stands the training ordeal.

J. E. Thorpe's pair Bluestone and Fisher are bright and well and may be expected to play their part well at the approaching meeting.

**TUESDAY.**

On Tuesday some good schooling took place before breakfast. Royal Regal was put over five of the schooling hurdles, fencing well.

Crispeen was given a like task over the same obstacles, clouting the last hurdle very hard.

Tararu Jack was content with one medium pace round, A. Julian being in the saddle. He looks very forward, and flew two small and two big hurdles, fencing well.

Spokane alone hopped over four of the pony hurdles, fencing a little bit wildly.

Aerofish, a full sister to Spalfish, pecked at the first hurdle and lost her rider. On being remounted she jumped two other hurdles without a mistake.

Nildah and Sir Stroud flew four of the small hurdles and two of the big battens, cutting out one of the little fences.

El Gallo and his stable mate Brookfield ran over five of the big schooling hurdles. The first-named will be all the better for a few more schooling lessons.

Laverna finished a long way in front of Genevieve over the same hurdles.

Soultikoff gave a much better display than Tragedy King over the ten big hurdles, covering the ground in 3 min 16 2-5sec. The last-named was a length off. Soultikoff carried a light impost.

Ulster, which has improved very much in his jumping of late, easily held Last Call over five of the big battens.

Marconi, who looks on the big side, had the best of Westerly, the Waikato hunter, over the timber.

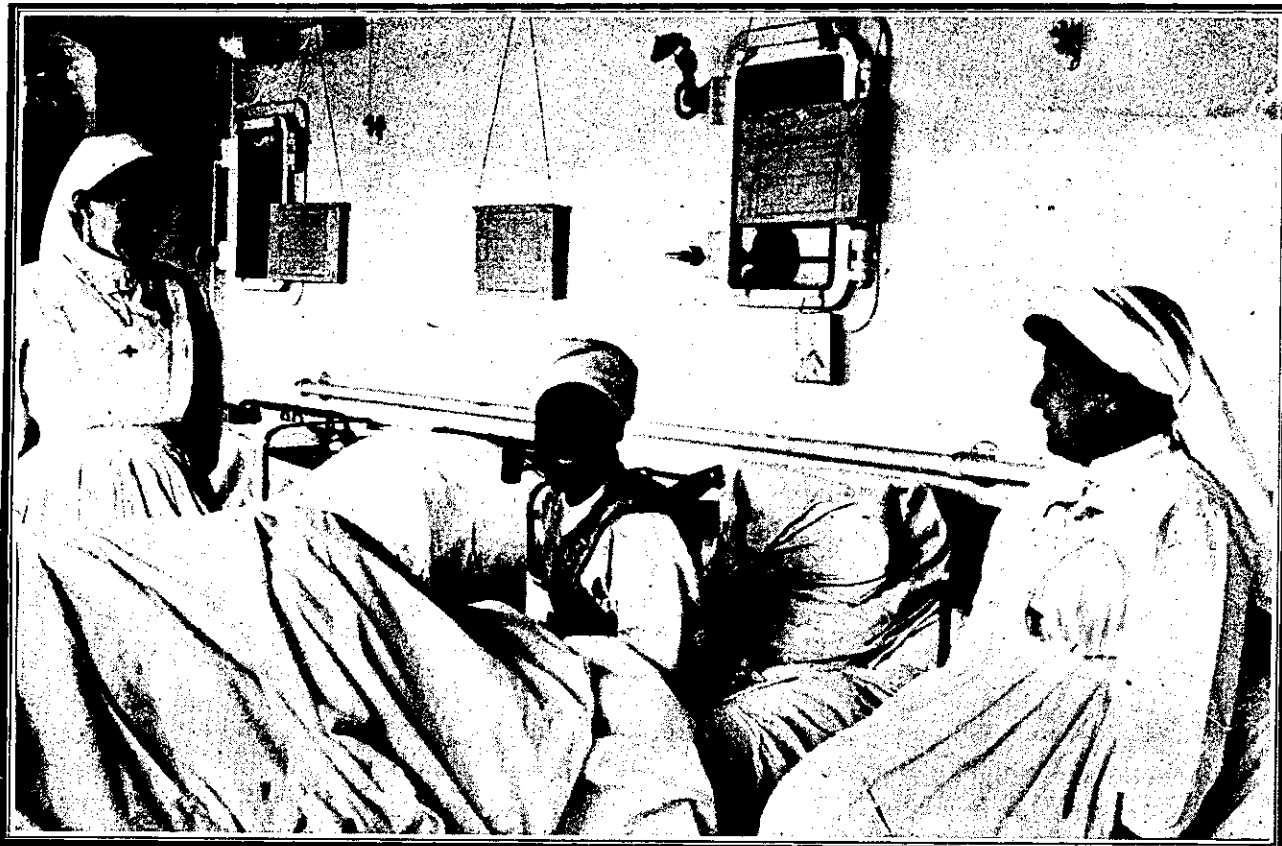
Tenacious alone put up a good display over ten big hurdles. Lady Lobelia joined in over the last couple. Tenacious is very fit.

Royal Lupin, one of J. Williamson's charges, fencing rather high, alone jumped four of the big battens.

The steeplechase course was opened outside the stone wall leading into the course proper, seven horses going to the post, viz., Te Onga, Lady Sabretache, Waimai, Tirau, Hockey, Hopye and Tangahere, Captain Lock joining in at the finish. The stone wall, sod wall, double jumps and old water jumps were negotiated, the horses running along in couples. Waimai and Te Onga pleased the most of the Great Northern candidates. Tangahere came down at the first of the double and negotiated the second fence without a rider. In the second round Waimai, Lady Sabretache and Captain Lock finished on terms. Waimai pleased the onlookers.
