6. Any person who shall run a horse in colours not duly registered in his name shall in every case pay to the Club a fine of 1sov for every start.

7. Any person intending to withdraw a horse, shall give notice in writing to that effect to the Secretary, or Clerk of the Scales, at least half an hour before the time appointed for starting. 8. Prior to any race the Stewards may order a parade in front of the lawn.
