Bay of Islands Service,

A delightful trip along the Northern Coast may be made by the s.s. Clausman, which leaves Auckland for Russell every Monday, returning on Tuesday, and leaves for Russell, Whangaroa, and Mongonui every Wednesday. The beauty of the Bay of Islands and Whangaroa, together with the many interesting places connected with the early history of the Dominion, cannot fail to please visitors.

Tauranga Service.

The s.s. Ngapuhi is now employed in this service, leaving Auckland every Monday and Thursday, and making the trip in 12 hours. For those who are looking round for a place in which to spend their summer holiday Tauranga has many attractions.

Great Barrier Service

A steamer leaves for Great Barrier every Wednesday at midnight, returning on Thursday evening. Good accommodation can be procured at a moderate charge both at Tryphena and Port Fitzroy. On the East Coast of the Island there is a fine sandy beach, extending for several miles.

Whangarei Service.

The s.s. Manaia runs regularly to Whangarei, whence a drive of four miles brings the visitor to the Kamo Soda Springs.

Special Summer Week End Trips.

During summer months week-end trips are run to Kawau, Waiwera, Waiheke, Grut's Orewa House, Algie's and Arkle's Bay. A special steamer leaves for the above ports every Saturday at 2 p.m., returning to Auckland about 9 a.m. on Monday. The return fare to Arkle's Bay is 5/6, Waiheke 6/-, Kawau, Waiwera, Grut's and Algie's 11/-. The accommodation for visitors at these places is excellent, and the charges very reasonable.

Onehunga-New Plymouth Service.

(conducted jointly with the Union Steam Ship Company, Limited).

The s.s. Rarawa runs regularly between Onehunga and New Plymouth, connecting with Express trains to and from Wellington.
