IMPROVERS' TROT HANDICAP (Saddle) of 75sovs; second horse to receive 10sovs, and third horse 5sovs each from the stake. **FOR TROT- TING HORSES ONLY.** For horses that have not won at better than 2.35 to the mile. Limit, 4.5. Nomination 20s., acceptance 30s. Distance, one mile and a-half.

Rule 172 New Zealand Rules of Trot- ting.—By the entry of or endeavouring to enter a horse, every person having or subsequently acquiring any interest in such horse, shall be deemed to accept all the conditions and restrictions im- posed or implied by these Rules, and to be barred from questioning the action of the Club or other body hold- ing a sports meeting or any official of the Club or such other body in respect of such horses, or of any person con- nected therewith otherwise than is pro- vided for in Part XXX. of the Rules.

The Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry and to exclude any person or persons from the ground without giving any explanation.

Before any horse can start the Pro- vident Fund fee must be paid, under a penalty of disqualification, vide Rules of Trotting.






