

About 28 are taught in a special class, and a good deal on the Montessori system. The children do all the cleaning of the school; they bring their lunches, make their own coffee, and wash their own cups. Each child has its own towel, and these they wash themselves. These children are much happier segregated, because when they are with much more forward children they feel their own inferiority. Here all are equal, and they have much more movement and freedom than in the ordinary school. Dr. Paterson strongly advocated such classes for backward children everywhere.
