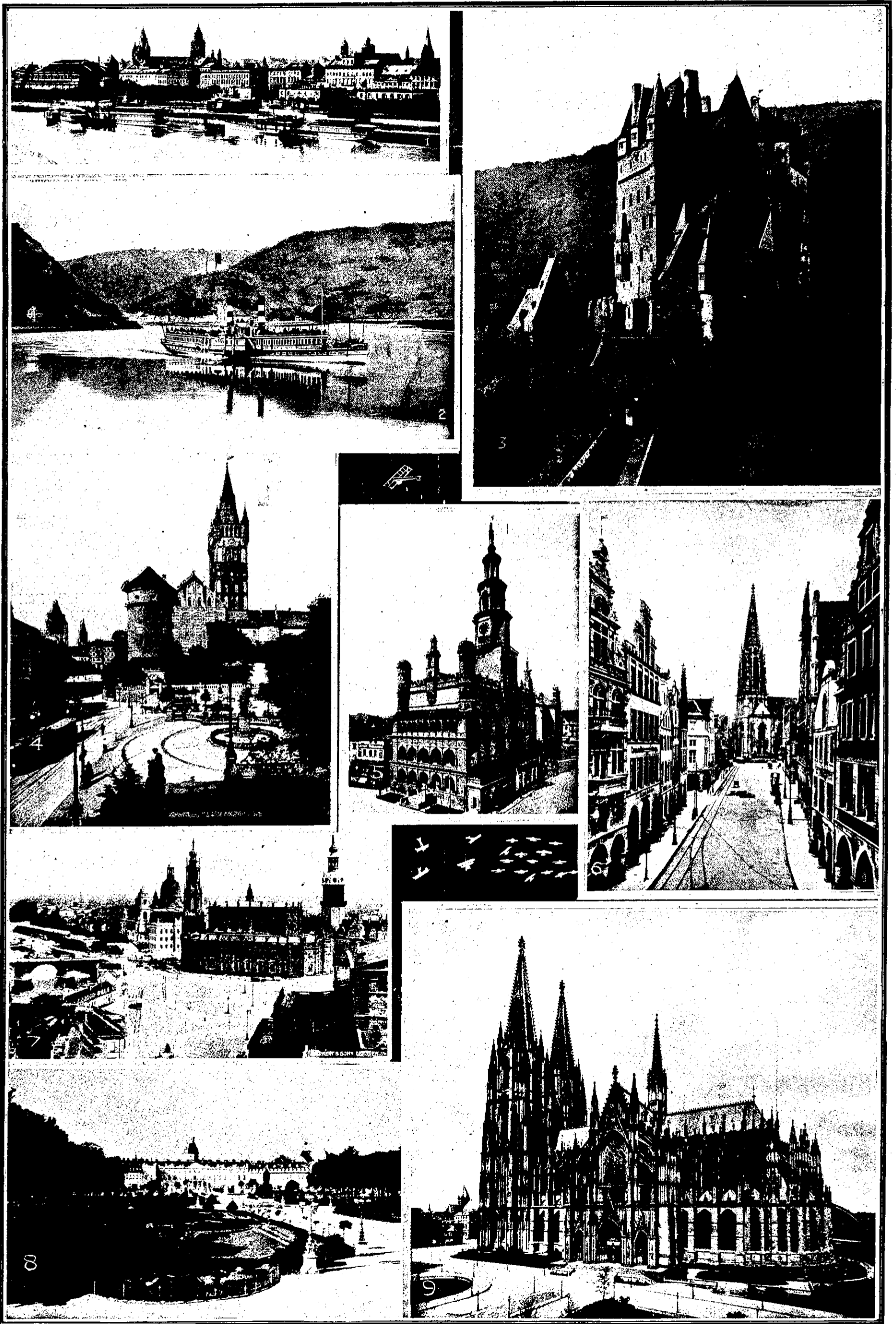


Notable Specimens of German Architecture, the desire to preserve which may prompt the Huns to Surrender.
