

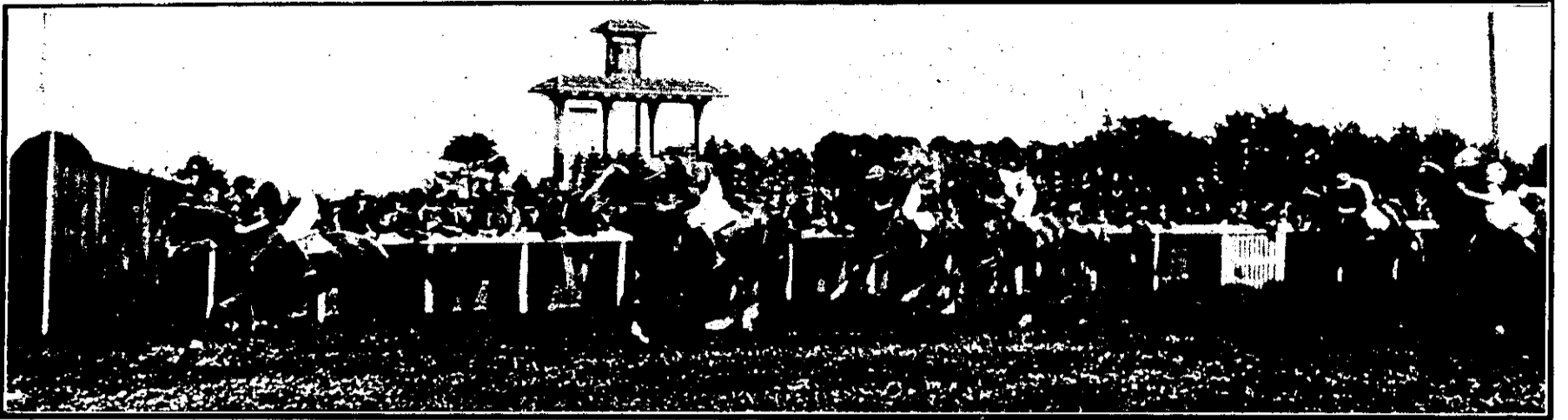

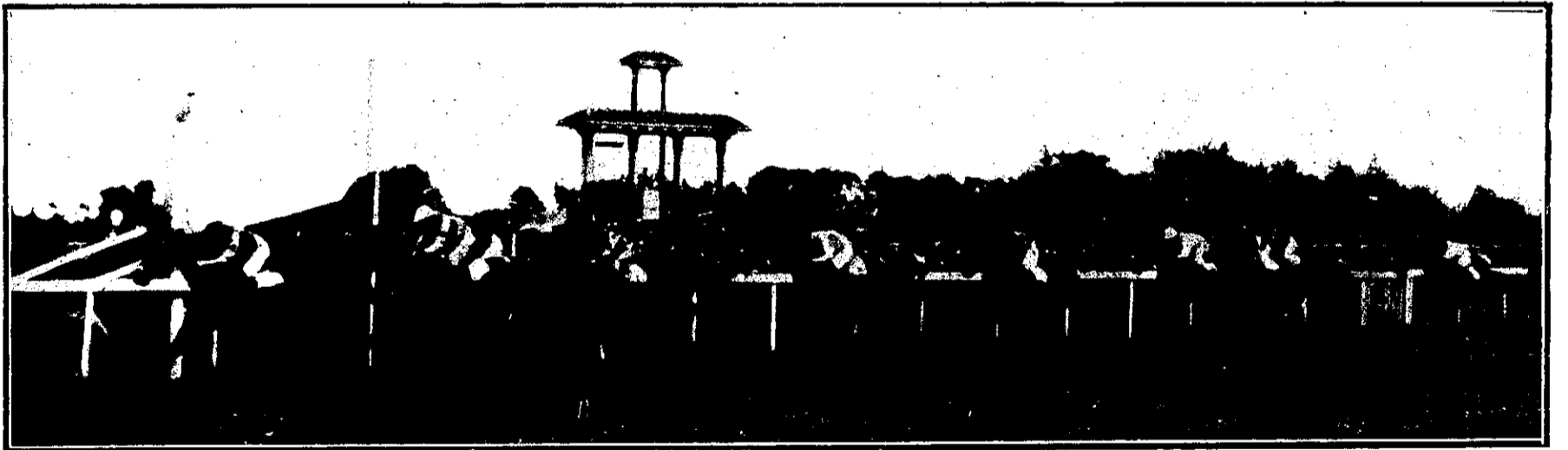
## Opening of the Racing Season in Auckland—Some Sterling Contests at the Avondale J.C.'s Spring Meeting on Saturday.



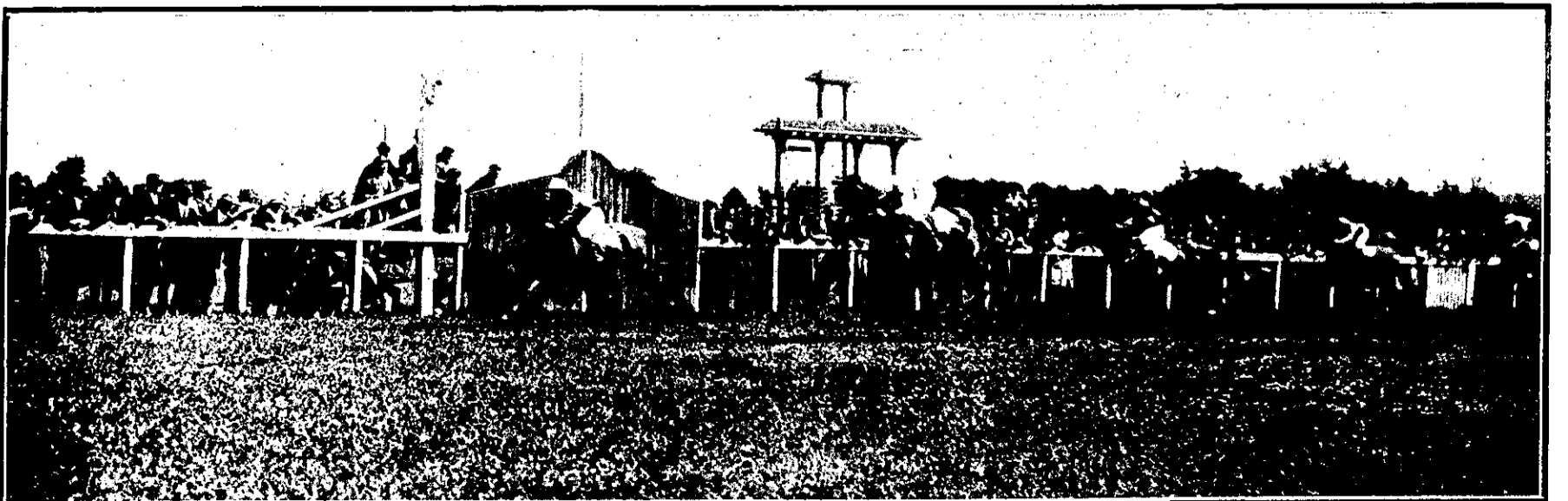
