RIFLEMAN L. H. BOTTCHER, of Stratford, Taranaki. Died from wounds.




RIFLEMAN J. H. MORRISON, of Hastings, Hawke's Bay. Killed in action.

PRIVATE G. W. HAXTON, of Carterton, Wairarapa. Died from wounds and pieuro-pneumonia.




PRIVATE ARTHUR DAVIDSON, of Timaru, South Canterbury. Killed in action.
